What is Project SEARCH?



- Project SEARCH is a one year internship, for students with disabilities, in a business setting, in their last year of school.
- It is targeted for students whose goal is competitive employment.
- The program takes place in a business setting where total immersion in the workplace facilitates the teaching and learning process, as well as the acquisition of employability and marketable work skills.
- Students participate in three internship rotations to explore a variety of jobs.
- The students work with a team that includes their family, a special education teacher, Vocational Rehab and Progress, Inc. to create an employment goal and support the student during this important transition from school to work.

Benefits to the Students

- Participate in a variety of internships within the host business
- Acquire competitive, transferable and marketable job skills
- Gain increased independence, confidence, and self esteem
- Obtain work based individual coaching, instruction and feedback
- Develop linkages to Vocational Rehab and other adult agencies
- Employment at the end of the Project SEARCH Program

Requirements

- Graduated from high school with either SPED diploma or Occupational Diploma
- Can come right from high school or from the CBTP program
- Must apply to Vocational Rehab and have an open case
- Application and interview process must be completed
- Their goal must be competitive employment
- Age 18-22








First Paycheck

Quinten is a Dining Room Attendant at a Local Restaurant








